Chair Marie Angelides called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

*Mr. Strange seconded the motion The vote was 4 in favor and 0 opposed. Mr. Lachiusa was absent.*

Ms. Angelides noted as part of the public discussion that there would be a luncheon for interim Town Manager Moynihan on November 14<sup>th</sup> (11:30 AM) and a reception for our new Town Manager (Lyn Simmons) on December 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Adult Center.

*Mr. Foster made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Gold. The vote was 4-0 with Mr. Lachiusa absent.*
