### **Weekend Schedule Both Pools: Saturday-Sunday**

<b>11:00am-7:00pm</b>	<b>Open Swim</b>
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**\* Children under the age of 14 yrs. must be accompanied by an adult.**

**\* Lap swim is for adults and older youth who swim laps consecutively, at Reynolds Pool only**

Season Passes must be shown for admission to the pools, otherwise a \$9 fee will be charged for residents and guests of residents, \$11 for non-residents.

**RESIDENT SEASON PASSES: \$70, INDIVIDUAL / \$225, HOUSEHOLD OF 4-6 PEOPLE**

**(Children age 3 and younger are free with an adult season pass holder or paid daily admission)**

## **RULES - RULES - RULES - RULES - RULES**

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1. All patrons must have proper swimsuits in order to enter pool area. Articles of clothing are not suitable for swimming. Locker/shower rooms are available for changing.
2. All patrons must take a shower before entering deck area.
3. No one is allowed in the pool or deck area having any infectious diseases, inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, poison ivy, or any communicable diseases of any kind. Persons with open sores, bandages, tape or ointments will not be permitted to use the pool.
4. Any person acting in a manner that could cause harm to themselves or others will be dismissed from the facility.
5. All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility.
6. The following are not allowed in the pool area: bottles or glass, sharp articles, clothing and bags, fins, snorkels, floatation devices, food and drink, animals, cigarettes, balls and toys, weapons, alcoholic beverages, drugs.
7. Food and drink will be confined to a specific area of the deck.
8. Children with swim diapers or plastic pant covered diapers will be allowed in pool - no disposable diapers.
9. No smoking or tobacco products of any kind allowed.
10. No running on deck.
11. No diving in shallow water (less than 5 feet deep).
12. Swimmers must pass a swim proficiency test before being permitted in the deep end of the pool.
13. No abusive or profane language or breach of peace will be tolerated.
14. Only one person is allowed on the diving board or slide at a time. Diving is permitted straight away from the board and the diver must use the ladder to exit the water.
15. The deep end is used for lap swimming from 5:00-7:00pm Monday through Friday at Reynolds Pool only.



16. No sitting or hanging on the lane lines.

### **Splash Pad Rules**

1. Splash Pad surface may be slippery when wet, use caution, footwear is strongly encouraged.
2. Children 10 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
3. Swim diapers are required for children who are not potty trained.
4. Do not swing, hang, pull, climb on or throw objects at spray equipment.
5. LPRD is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
6. No skateboarding, rollerblading, bicycling, scooters, pets, baby strollers, water balloons, beach balls, or toys are allowed in and around the splash pad area.
7. All participants must conduct themselves in a well-mannered and safe manner. LPRD reserves the right to remove parties from the splash pad that are not in compliance with the splash pad rules.
8. No food or beverages are allowed in or on the splash pad area.
9. Please clear or exit the area when conditions for lightning are possible.
